### **OLD TESTAMENT**

#### **GENESIS 4:7**

- 7 If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must master it."

#### **GENESIS 6:5-6, 11-13**

- 5 The LORD saw how great man's wickedness on the earth had become, and that every inclination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil all the time.
- 6 The LORD was grieved that he had made man on the earth, and his heart was filled with pain.
- 11 Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight and was full of violence.
- 12 God saw how corrupt the earth had become, for all the people on earth had corrupted their ways.
- 13 So God said to Noah, "I am going to put an end to all people, for the earth is filled with violence because of them. I am surely going to destroy both them and the earth.

**GENESIS 9:5-6**

- 5 And for your lifeblood I will surely demand an accounting. I will demand an accounting from every animal. And from each man, too, I will demand an accounting for the life of his fellow man.
- 6 "Whoever sheds the blood of man, by man shall his blood be shed; for in the image of God has God made man.

**EXODUS 15:26**

- 26 He said, "If you **listen** carefully to the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in his eyes, if you pay attention to his commands and keep all his decrees, I will not bring on you any of the diseases I brought on the Egyptians, for I am the LORD, who heals you."

**EXODUS 19:5-6**

- 5 Now if you **obey** me fully and **keep** my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine,
- 6 you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites."

**EXODUS 34:11-14**

- 11 **Obey** what I command you today. I will drive out before you the Amorites, Canaanites, Hittites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites.
- 12 **Be careful** not to make a treaty with those who live in the land where you are going, or they will be a snare among you.
- 13 **Break down** their altars, smash their sacred stones and cut down their Asherah poles.
- 14 **Do not worship** any other god, for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God.

**LEVITICUS 26:1-13**

- 1 "**Do not make idols** or set up an image or a sacred stone for yourselves, and do not place a carved stone in your land to bow down before it. I am the LORD your God.
- 2 "**Observe** my Sabbaths and have reverence for my sanctuary. I am the LORD.
- 3 "If you follow my decrees and are careful to obey my commands,
- 4 I will send you rain in its season, and the ground will yield its crops and the trees of the field their fruit.

## Conditions

- 5 Your threshing will continue until grape harvest and the grape harvest will continue until planting, and you will eat all the food you want and live in safety in your land.
- 6 "I will grant peace in the land, and you will lie down and no one will make you afraid. I will remove savage beasts from the land, and the sword will not pass through your country.
- 7 You will pursue your enemies, and they will fall by the sword before you.
- 8 Five of you will chase a hundred, and a hundred of you will chase ten thousand, and your enemies will fall by the sword before you.
- 9 "I will look on you with favor and make you fruitful and increase your numbers, and I will keep my covenant with you.
- 10 You will still be eating last year's harvest when you will have to move it out to make room for the new.
- 11 I will put my dwelling place among you, and I will not abhor you.
- 12 I will walk among you and be your God, and you will be my people.
- 13 I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt so that you would no longer be slaves to the Egyptians; I broke the bars of your yoke and enabled you to walk with heads held high.

### DEUTERONOMY 5:29, 32-33

- 29 Oh, that their hearts would be inclined to **fear me** and **keep all my** commands always, so that it might go well with them and their children forever!
- 32 **So be careful** to do what the LORD your God has commanded you; do not turn aside to the right or to the left.
- 33 **Walk in all the** way that the LORD your God has commanded you, so that you may live and prosper and prolong your days in the land that you will possess.

### DEUTERONOMY 6:17-18

- 17 Be sure to **keep the commands of the LORD** your God and the stipulations and decrees he has given you.
- 18 **Do what is right and good** in the Lord's sight, so that it may go well with you and you may go in and take over the good land that the LORD promised on oath to your forefathers,

### DEUTERONOMY 11:26-28, 32

- 26 See, I am setting before you today a blessing and a curse--

## *Conditions*

- 27 the blessing if you obey the commands of the LORD your God that I am giving you today;
- 28 the curse if you disobey the commands of the LORD your God and turn from the way that I command you today by following other gods, which you have not known.
- 32 be sure that you obey all the decrees and laws I am setting before you today.

### **DEUTERONOMY 28:1, 9, 14**

- 1 If you fully obey the Lord your God and carefully follow all his commands I give you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations on earth.
- 9 The Lord will establish you as his holy people, as he promised you on oath, if you keep the commands of the Lord your God and walk in his ways.
- 14 Do not turn aside from any of the commands I give you today, to the right or to the left, following other gods and serving them.

### **DEUTERONOMY 29:9**

- 9 Carefully follow the terms of this covenant, so that you may prosper in everything you do.

### **DEUTERONOMY 30:1-3, 8, 10, 16, 19-20**

- 1 When all these blessings and curses I have set before you come upon you and you take them to heart wherever the Lord your God disperses you among the nations,
- 2 and when you and your children return to the Lord your God and obey him with all your heart and with all your soul according to everything I command you today,
- 3 then the Lord your God will restore your fortunes and have compassion on you and gather you again from all the nations where he scattered you.
- 8 You will again obey the Lord and follow all his commands I am giving you today.
- 10 if you obey the Lord your God and keep his commands and decrees that are written in this Book of the Law and turn to the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul.
- 16 For I command you today to love the Lord your God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commands, decrees and laws; then you will live and increase, and the Lord your God will bless you in the land you are entering to possess.

- 19 This day I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you that I  
have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. Now  
choose life, so that you and your children may live  
20 and that you may love the Lord your God, listen to his voice, and  
hold fast to him. For the Lord is your life, and he will give you  
many years in the land he swore to give to your fathers,  
Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

**JOSHUA 1:6-9**

- 7 Be **strong** and **very courageous**. Be careful to **obey** all the law  
my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to  
the left, that you may be successful wherever you go.  
8 **Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth;**  
**meditate** on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do  
everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and  
successful.  
9 Have I not commanded you? **Be strong and courageous. Do  
not be terrified; do not be discouraged**, for the Lord your God  
will be with you wherever you go.”

**JOSHUA 14:8-9**

- 8 but my brothers who went up with me made the hearts of the  
people melt with fear. I, however, **followed the Lord my God  
wholeheartedly**.  
9 So on that day Moses swore to me, ‘The land on which your feet  
have walked will be your inheritance and that of your children  
forever, because you have followed the Lord my God  
wholeheartedly.’

**JOSHUA 22:5**

- 22 But **be very careful** to keep the commandment and the law that  
Moses the servant of the Lord gave you: to love the Lord your  
God, to walk in all his ways, to obey his commands, to hold fast  
to him and to serve him with all your heart and all your soul.”

**1 KINGS 2:3-4**

- 3 and observe what the Lord your God requires: Walk in his ways,  
and keep his decrees and commands, his laws and requirements,  
as written in the Law of Moses, so that you may prosper in all  
you do and wherever you go,  
4 and that the Lord may keep his promise to me: ‘If your  
descendants watch how they live, and if they walk faithfully
